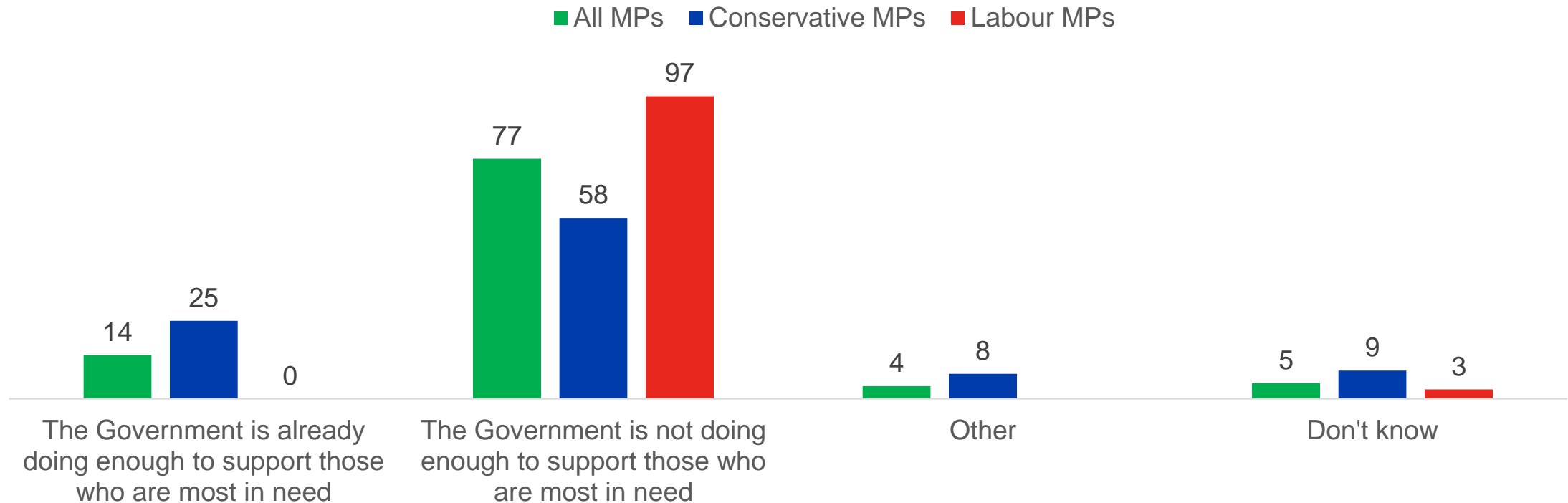


# There is a broad consensus among MPs that the Government is *not* doing enough to support those who are most in need during this cost-of-living crisis

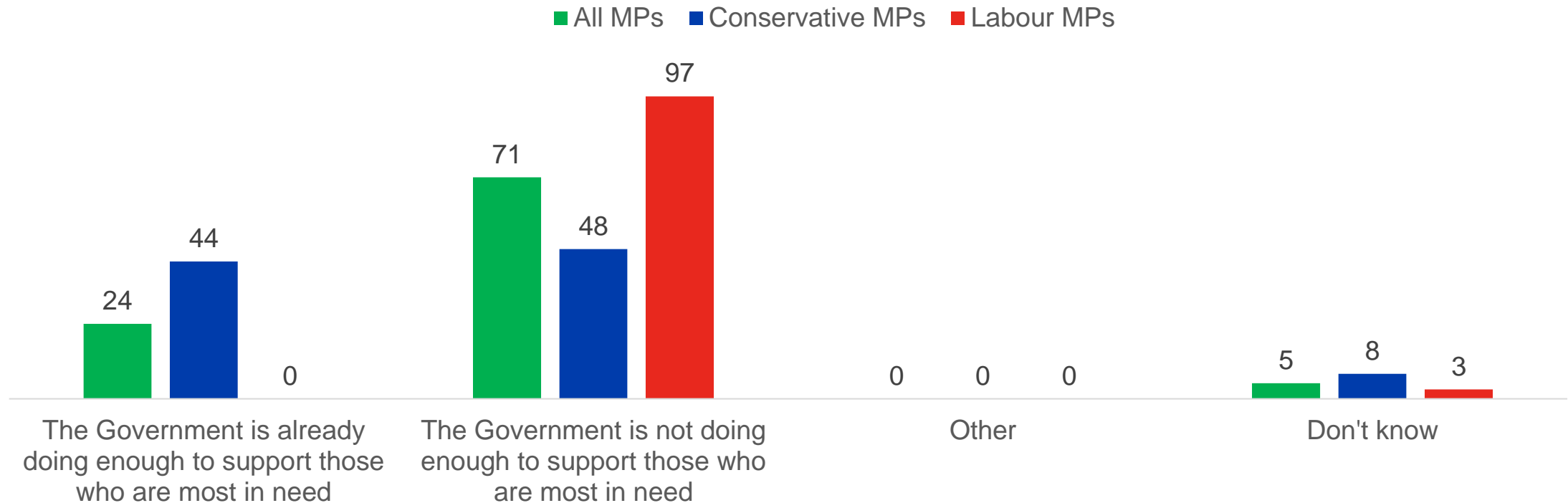
Thinking about the cost-of-living crisis currently facing the UK, which of the following statements comes closest to your views?

And, thinking about the impact of the cost-of-living crisis on UK business, which of the following statements comes closest to your views?

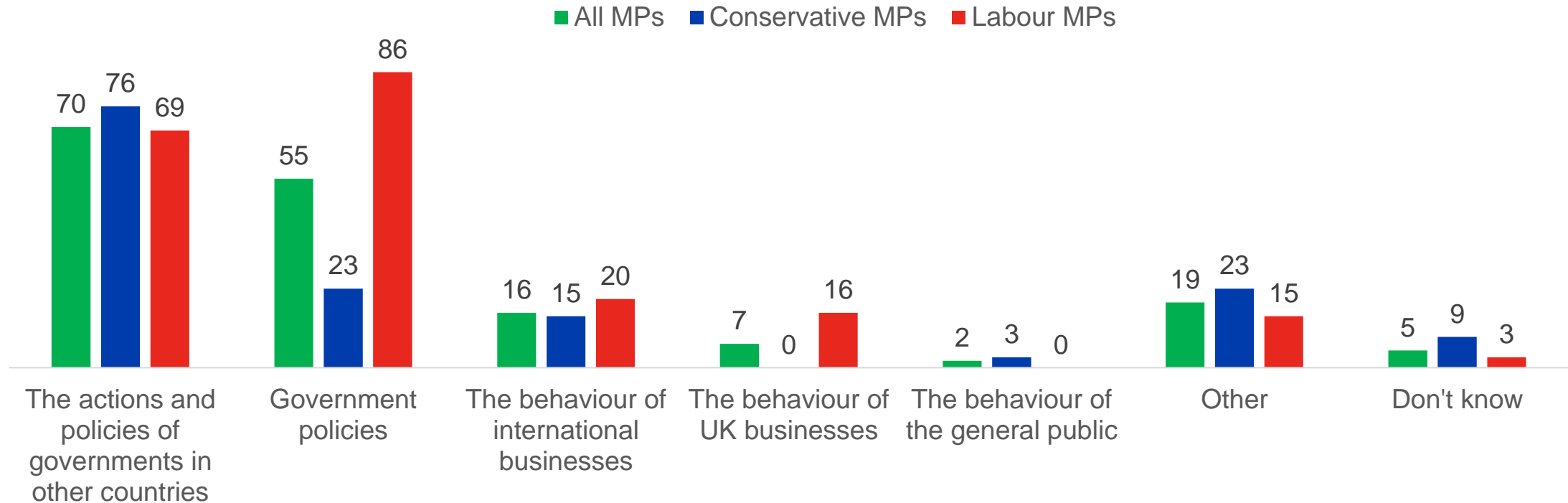

Please select all that apply.

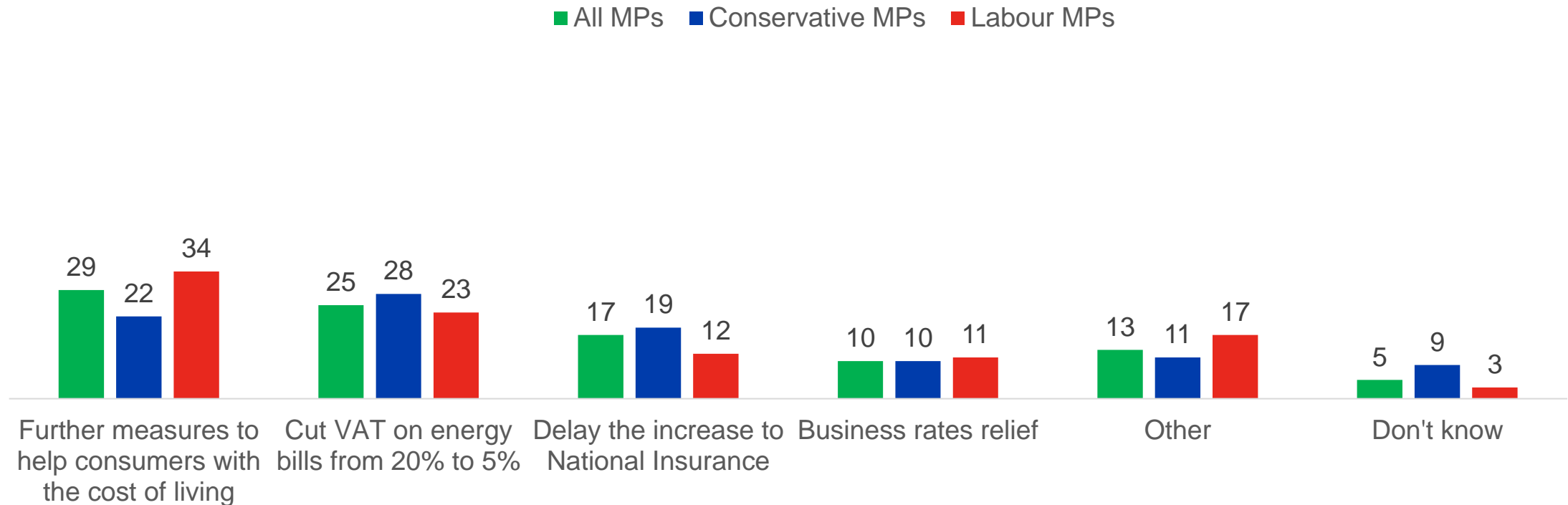
