During the coronavirus outbreak the Government paid 80% of the wages of people who had been temporarily laid off (or “furloughed”) from work. The furlough scheme is due to be phased out from 1st July, with the Government paying 70% of wages in July, 60% in August, 50% in September, and the scheme ending completely by 30th September. The Government has pushed Step 4 of the roadmap back to 19th July, but it has been reported that the furlough scheme will be phased out as planned.
