YouGov Weighting Data

YouGov weights GB political surveys by (1) age interlocked with education, (2) political attention interlocked with party identification (3) social grade and (4) 2015 recalled vote interlocked with region. Weighting targets are YouGov estimates, data sources used in the calculation of targets are cited below. General election voting intention figures are additionally weighted by likelihood to vote. The poll was carried out online.

For this poll we have additionally weighted our EU referendum voting intentions by likelihood to vote, and downweighted respondents who did not vote at the last general election.

Respondents from Northern Ireland have been weighted by age, gender, whether they voted at the last general election and whether they consider themselves to be Protestant, Catholic or Neither.
