METHODOLOGY

YouGov interviewed 1,821 U.S. adults between January 23-26, 2026 for The Times.

This sample was weighted according to gender, age, race, and education based on the U.S. Census American Community Survey, and the U.S. Census Current Population Survey, as well as 2024 Presidential vote, 2020 Presidential vote and 2024 baseline partisan identification. Respondents were selected to be representative of U.S. adults. The weights range from 0.1 to 5.0, with a mean of 1 and a standard deviation of 0.6.

The margin of error for a percentage based upon the entire sample is ± 2.7 points. The margin of error is larger for subsamples and differences of percentages.
