<b>Positioning of voting intention questions in questionnaire?</b>	Immediately after demographics
<b>How were undecided voters handled?</b>	Undecided respondents who answered “don’t know” were asked a leaner question which also included a “don’t know” option. Those who answered don’t know were excluded from published voting intention figures but not from the survey.
