Sampling method Respondents were selected from YouGov's opt-in panel to be repre-

sentative of adult U.S. citizens.

Sample composition 1,835 started the survey after screenouts. 116 were deleted due to

breakoffs, 33 were removed for interview completion time under 5 minutes, 6 were removed for attention check failures, and 42 were removed for data quality control. The reporting is based on the re-

maining 1,638 respondents.

Weighting The sample was weighted according to gender, age, race, educa-

tion, 2024 election turnout and presidential vote, 2020 election turnout and presidential vote, baseline party identification, and current voter registration status. 2024 presidential vote, at time of weighting was estimated to be 48% Harris and 50% Trump. Demographic weighting targets come from the 2019 American Community Survey. Baseline party identification is the respondent's most recent answer given around November 8, 2024, and is weighted to the estimated distribution at that time (31% Democratic, 33% Republican). The weights range from 0.052 to 8.202, with a mean of one and a standard devia-

tion of 1.179.
