Voter registration was imputed from the November 2018 Current Population Survey Regis- tration and Voting Supplement.
Weighting	The sample was weighted based on gender, age, race, education, news interest, and 2020 Presidential vote (or non-vote). The weights range from 0.216 to 6.075, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.641.
