METHODOLOGY

These YouGov polls were conducted online among U.S. adults. Surveys were fielded every 4 weeks between February 21, 2024 and January 28, 2025 for the SAY24 project for Stanford, Arizona State, and Yale Universities. Between 4,730 and 6,813 respondents completed each survey. 94,103 adults completed a larger SAY24 survey between April 28 and June 23, 2025.

Each sample was weighted according to gender, age, race, and education based on the U.S. Census American Community Survey, and the U.S. Census Current Population Survey, as well as 2020 Presidential vote and partisan identification. Weights for each survey range from 0.04 to 7.1, with a mean of 1 and standard deviations ranging from 1.1 to 1.5.

The margin of error for a percentage based upon the entire sample for each month ranges between ± 0.5 and ± 2.5 points. The margin of error is larger for subsamples and differences of percentages.
