Asked of people who said that they are somewhat or very pro-choice, or are not sure

- 1) Become more accessible. People will eventually regain safe and legal abortion access. 17%
- 2) Stay at the same level of limited accessibility post-Roe 13%
- 3) Become even less accessible. I believe I will see further successful attacks on abortion access in the future36%
- 4) Not sure 34%

Weighting	Data is weighted on gender, education level, and ethnicity to be nationally representative of U.S. adults ages 18-25 in the United States. The weights range from 0.347 to 5.893, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.758.
