Sample 1000 U.S. Adult Citizens
Conducted April 7 - 10, 2022
Margin of Error $\pm 3.4\%$

1. Which comes closer to your view?

People should be free to buy land and develop real estate where they please55%
The government should limit where people are allowed to build things45%

2. Which comes closer to your view?

It's better for the environment if houses are built closer together25%
It's better for the environment if houses are built farther apart75%

3. Which comes closer to your view?

Higher-density development creates more traffic since people are living closer together .60%
Higher-density development creates less traffic by making it easier to walk and use public transit

Interviewing Dates

April 7 - 10, 2022

Target population

U.S. Citizens, aged 18 and over.

Sampling method

Respondents were selected from YouGov's opt-in Internet panel using sample matching. A random sample (stratified by gender, age, race, education, geographic region, and voter registration) was selected from the 2018 American Community Study. Voter registration was imputed from the November 2018 Current Population Survey Registration and Voting Supplement.

Weighting

The sample was weighted based on gender, age, race, education, news interest, and 2020 Presidential vote (or non-vote). The weights range from 0.384 to 4.897, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.415.
