1. What statement best describes how clean you are in a kitchen?

I always clean my dishes and put things away quickly ..... 43%  
 I sometimes leave dirty things out, but not for long ..... 47%  
 I often leave dirty dishes out and don't tidy up that often ..... 7%  
 Not sure ..... 3%

2. If someone that you live or work with routinely left dirty dishes out, what would you do?

Tell them to clean up after themselves ..... 52%  
 Start leaving your dirty dishes out too ..... 2%  
 Leave their dishes unwashed, but don't say anything ..... 10%  
 Do the dishes for them ..... 29%  
 Not sure ..... 8%

3. Do you think that you could happily live with someone who has much LOWER standards of cleanliness than you?

Definitely ..... 4%  
 Probably ..... 23%  
 Probably not ..... 41%  
 Definitely not ..... 23%  
 Not sure ..... 8%

4. Do you think that you could happily live with someone who has much HIGHER standards of cleanliness than you?

Definitely ..... 27%  
 Probably ..... 48%

<b>Interviewing Dates</b>	December 10 - 14, 2015
<b>Target population</b>	U.S. adults, aged 18 and over.
<b>Sampling method</b>	Respondents were selected from YouGov's opt-in Internet panel using sample matching. A random sample (stratified by age, gender, race, education, and region) was selected from the 2010 American Community Study. Voter registration was imputed from the November 2010 Current Population Survey Registration and Voting Supplement. Religion, minor party identification, and non-placement on an ideology scale, were imputed from the 2008 Pew Religion in American Life Survey.
<b>Weighting</b>	The sample was weighted using propensity scores based on age, gender, race, education, voter registration, and non-placement on an ideology scale. The weights range from 0.193 to 4.118, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.92.
<b>Number of respondents</b>	1000
<b>Margin of error</b>	± 4.2% (adjusted for weighting)
<b>Survey mode</b>	Web-based interviews
<b>Questions not reported</b>	20 questions not reported.
