

Daily Survey: Offering a Meal



Sample 1000 U.S. Adult Citizens
Conducted May 31 - June 3, 2022
Margin of Error $\pm 3.4\%$

1. If you had an unexpected guest in your home who was still there at mealtime, but not expecting to stay the night, which of the following would you generally do?

- Ask/encourage them to leave prior to your meal 8%
- Allow them to stay in your home while you eat, but not offer to feed them 10%
- Offer for them to join you for your meal 72%
- Not sure 10%

2. If you were at someone's house at mealtime, but not expecting to stay the night, which of the following would you generally want them to do?

- Ask/encourage you to leave prior to their meal 14%
- Allow you to stay in their home while they eat, but not offer to feed you 11%
- Offer for you to join for their meal 55%
- Not sure 19%

Interviewing Dates	May 31 - June 3, 2022
Target population	U.S. Citizens, aged 18 and over.
Sampling method	Respondents were selected from YouGov's opt-in Internet panel using sample matching. A random sample (stratified by gender, age, race, education, geographic region, and voter registration) was selected from the 2018 American Community Study. Voter registration was imputed from the November 2018 Current Population Survey Registration and Voting Supplement.
Weighting	The sample was weighted based on gender, age, race, education, news interest, and 2020 Presidential vote (or non-vote). The weights range from 0.273 to 5.362, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.414.

Margin of error	$\pm 3.4\%$ (adjusted for weighting)
