1. Facebook's Oversight Board will announce on Wednesday whether President Donald Trump will be allowed to use Facebook again. Do you believe that Facebook should reinstate President Trump's access to Facebook, or not?

They should 46%
They should not 39%

2. Do you believe Facebook made the right or wrong decision by indefinitely locking President Donald Trump out of Facebook after he used his social media accounts to encourage his supporters to storm the Capitol?

Right decision 49%
Wrong decision 36%
Don't know 15%

3. In general, do you think social media outlets are:

Biased in favor of Democrats 39%
Biased in favor of Republicans 12%
Not politically biased either way 29%
Don't know 20%

Interviewing Dates	May 4 - 6, 2021
Target population	U.S. Citizens, aged 18 and over.
Sampling method	Respondents were selected from YouGov's opt-in Internet panel using sample matching. A random sample (stratified by gender, age, race, education, geographic region, and voter registration) was selected from the 2016 American Community Study. Voter registration was imputed from the November 2016 Current Population Survey Registration and Voting Supplement.
Weighting	The sample was weighted based on gender, age, race, education, news interest, and 2016 Presidential vote (or non-vote). The weights range from 0.255 to 3.088, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.427.
