

Daily Survey: Refugees

Sample 1000 U.S. Adult Citizens
Conducted March 4 - 7, 2022
Margin of Error $\pm 3.4\%$

1. Do you think the United States should or should not accept refugees fleeing violence in Ukraine?

Asked of a randomly assigned half-sample

Should	61%
Should not	17%
Not sure	22%

2. Do you think the United States should or should not accept refugees fleeing violence in Afghanistan?

Asked of a randomly assigned half-sample

Should	46%
Should not	29%
Not sure	24%

Interviewing Dates	March 4 - 7, 2022
Target population	U.S. Citizens, aged 18 and over.
Sampling method	Respondents were selected from YouGov's opt-in Internet panel using sample matching. A random sample (stratified by gender, age, race, education, geographic region, and voter registration) was selected from the 2018 American Community Study. Voter registration was imputed from the November 2018 Current Population Survey Registration and Voting Supplement.
Weighting	The sample was weighted based on gender, age, race, education, news interest, and 2020 Presidential vote (or non-vote). The weights range from 0.293 to 4.659, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.428.
