1. Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of R. Kelly?

Very favorable	4%
Somewhat favorable	7%
Somewhat unfavorable	12%
Very unfavorable	53%
Don't know	23%

2. How much have you heard about R. Kelly being sentenced to 30 years in prison for federal racketeering and sex trafficking?

A lot	19%
A little	61%
Nothing at all	20%

3. Do you think R. Kelly's sentence of 30 years in prison is too short, too long, or about right?

Too short	25%
Too long	6%
About right	44%
Not sure	25%

Interviewing Dates

June 30 - July 6, 2022

Target population

U.S. Citizens, aged 18 and over.

Sampling method

Respondents were selected from YouGov's opt-in Internet panel using sample matching. A random sample (stratified by gender, age, race, education, geographic region, and voter registration) was selected from the 2018 American Community Study. Voter registration was imputed from the November 2018 Current Population Survey Registration and Voting Supplement.

Weighting

The sample was weighted based on gender, age, race, education, news interest, and 2020 Presidential vote (or non-vote). The weights range from 0.345 to 2.613, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.275.
