2. Did you ever have a school teacher during K-12 or post-secondary education who you would say changed your life for the worse?

Yes	22%
No	63%
Not sure	14%

3. Thinking about the school teacher who had the most significant impact on changing your life for the better, when or how did you meet them?

In 6th - 8th grade	13%

# Daily Survey: The Impact of Teachers



<b>Interviewing Dates</b>	August 11 - 15, 2022
<b>Target population</b>	U.S. Citizens, aged 18 and over.
<b>Sampling method</b>	Respondents were selected from YouGov's opt-in Internet panel using sample matching. A random sample (stratified by gender, age, race, education, geographic region, and voter registration) was selected from the 2018 American Community Study. Voter registration was imputed from the November 2018 Current Population Survey Registration and Voting Supplement.
<b>Weighting</b>	The sample was weighted based on gender, age, race, education, news interest, and 2020 Presidential vote (or non-vote). The weights range from 0.202 to 4.675, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.373.
<b>Number of respondents</b>	1000
<b>Margin of error</b>	± 3.3% (adjusted for weighting)
<b>Survey mode</b>	Web-based interviews
<b>Questions not reported</b>	61 questions not reported.
