

Daily Survey: Valentine's Day



Sample 1000 U.S. Adult Citizens
Conducted February 10 - 14, 2022
Margin of Error $\pm 3.3\%$

1. Would Donald Trump be a perfect companion for Valentine's Day, would he be acceptable but not your first choice, or would you not want to spend Valentine's Day with this person?

Perfect companion 13%
Acceptable but not first choice 25%
Would not want to spend the day with him 62%

2. Would Joe Biden be a perfect companion for Valentine's Day, would he be acceptable but not your first choice, or would you not want to spend Valentine's Day with this person?

Perfect companion 11%
Acceptable but not first choice 28%
Would not want to spend the day with him 61%

Interviewing Dates	February 10 - 14, 2022
Target population	U.S. Citizens, aged 18 and over.
Sampling method	Respondents were selected from YouGov's opt-in Internet panel using sample matching. A random sample (stratified by gender, age, race, education, geographic region, and voter registration) was selected from the 2018 American Community Study. Voter registration was imputed from the November 2018 Current Population Survey Registration and Voting Supplement.
Weighting	The sample was weighted based on gender, age, race, education, news interest, and 2020 Presidential vote (or non-vote). The weights range from 0.24 to 4.823, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.394.

Margin of error	$\pm 3.3\%$ (adjusted for weighting)
