METHODOLOGY

This survey was fielded between August 23 and September 17, 2024, for the SAY24 project for Stanford, Arizona State, and Yale Universities. 113,445 U.S. adults completed the survey. Respondents were selected to be representative of the U.S. adult population.

The sample was weighted according to gender, age, race, education, and region based on the U.S. Census American Community Survey and the U.S. Census Current Population Survey, as well as 2020 presidential vote and partisan identification. Weights range from 0.04 to 6.33, with a mean of 1 and a standard deviation of 1.31.

The margin of error for a percentage based upon the entire sample is ± 0.4 points. The margin of error is larger for subsamples and differences of percentages.
