Target population	Registered Voters in Georgia
Sample	Stratified random sample of voters selected from a list of Georgia registered voters who were contacted via text message and interviewed on YouGov's web-based survey system. Voters were selected at random within each stratum until the target number of interviews were completed.
Weighting	The sample was weighted to gender, age, race, in-state geography (using the current Georgia voter list), and imputed education, party score, 2024 presidential vote, and past Senate vote. Likely voters are defined by two screening criteria – a strict and a loose definition. The strict definition includes those who self-report “Definitely will vote” and voted in 2024 (or are newly eligible to vote). The loose definition also includes those who “Probably will vote”, or those who did not vote in 2024 but report they are “Definitely” likely to vote this year. Weights were computed using the method of raking. The weights range from 0.1 to 8.6 with a coefficient of variation of 1.3.
